Although a few patches of snow still linger around my house, spring is pushing its way into New England, which means more light streaming through my window as I write.

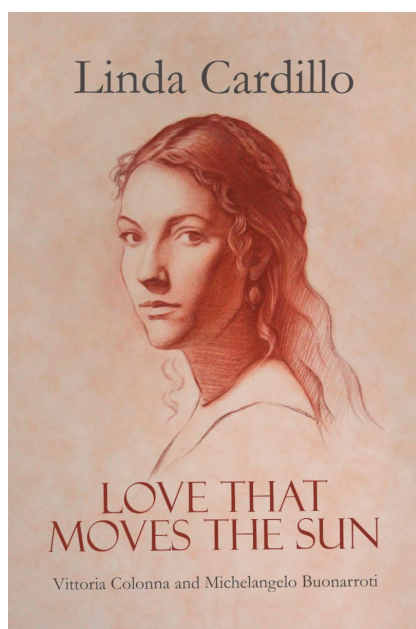
Upcoming Events
